

College Bound Graduates

In order to apply to an Ontario college, you must apply through the Ontario College application center (www.ontariocolleges.ca). To apply to a college outside Ontario, you must apply to each college individually (i.e. go to their website and apply online).

*****Please book an appointment with your guidance counsellor before December 1st to ensure you have all the required courses and general requirements to graduate and apply to college (and to receive your OEN).*****

Important Dates for Ontario Colleges and SJCSS Graduates

October 2017

- Access open to apply to college for the 2018 – 2019 academic year through www.ontariocolleges.ca .

October 6th, 2017

- **CIP (College Information Program)**
At St Lawrence College in Kingston (Bus provided) 9:00 AM – 3:30 PM
Bus space is limited. Please sign up early

October 15th, 2017

- Student information sent to colleges for the first time. This is the earliest date that colleges may acknowledge applications.

February 1st, 2018

- Applications received and paid for by this date will be given equal consideration by the colleges.
- Note that applications to Highly Competitive Programs must be received by this date in order to be considered. As these programs receive a high volume of applicants, all seats may be filled by February 1.
- Earliest date to receive offer of admission

May 1st, 2018

- Deadline to confirm offer of admission unless offer is made after May 1st

June 15th, 2018

- Earliest date that colleges may require payment of tuition fees.

June 27th, 2018 (Tentative)

- Graduation Day
- ***Grad gown payment of \$25 and community hours (Minimum of 40 hours) must be submitted before prom (Mid May). If not submitted, graduates will not be permitted to purchase tickets to attend prom.***
