Name of Course: Media Arts ASM30

Course Prerequisite Any Grade 9 or 10 course in the arts

Course Description:

This course of study are designed to prepare students to meet the challenges of a technologically advanced society. A focus on the creative process gives students practical skills, appropriate motivation, and the theoretical knowledge needed to communicate ideas, feelings, and beliefs through the media artwork they create. In addition, students develop an appreciation and awareness of this new and innovative art discipline.
