Name of Course/Course Code: English, Grade 11 College Preparation, ENG 3C

Course Prerequisite: English, Grade 10, Applied

Course Description: This course emphasizes the development of literacy, communication, and critical and creative thinking skills necessary for success in academic and daily life. Students will study the content, form, and style of a variety of informational and graphic texts, as well as literary texts from Canada and other countries, and create oral, written, and media texts in a variety of forms for practical and academic purposes. An important focus will be on using language with precision and clarity. The course is intended to prepare students for the compulsory Grade 12 college preparation course.

Catholic Graduate Expectations: The English curriculum provides many opportunities for students to fulfill many of the Catholic Graduate expectations in that students and the teacher have moments to share ideas, thoughts, feelings, reactions, dreams, hopes, and prayers.
