Name of Course/Course Code: FIF3U

Course Prerequisite: FIF2D

Course Description: This course develops knowledge and language skills through the study of Francophone literature and culture from around the world. Students will study novels, plays, poems, short stories, films, and nonfiction works and produce written assignments in a variety of forms, including critiques and newspaper articles. They will also write a formal research essay. The use of correct grammar and appropriate language conventions in both spoken and written French will be emphasized throughout the course.

Catholic Graduate Expectations: Students will be expected to listen, speak, read, write sensitively, and respond in French in light of Gospel values. They will be expected to be responsible citizens who respect the Catholic teachings of peace, justice, and the sacredness of human life.
