**Communications Technology Grade 12 – TGJ4M**

**Course Prerequisite:** Communications Technology, Grade 11, University/College Preparation

**Course Description:**

This course examines communications systems and design and production processes in the areas of electronic, live, recorded, and graphic communications. Students will create, manage, and distribute complex electronic, graphic, recorded, or audio-visual projects independently and in project teams.
